Fourth and Gill Walking Trail

The Fourth and Gill Dogwood Walking Tour returns
in 2008. The revitalized neighborhood features
restored Victorian homes first built in the 1880s.
Many of the homes' landscaping includes original
trees, plants, and shrubberies. This trail provides
a leisurely stroll down the memory lane of historic
North Knoxville, beautified and shared by Fourth
and Gill's gracious residents.

**Knox County Champion Bald Cypress, 111
Luttrell**, behind the house on the left, and another
at **1106 Broadway**. These non-native trees were
probably planted at the same time and are at least
100 years old.

Directions: From downtown Knoxville travel north
on Broadway for about two miles. Turn right onto
Glenwood and park at Brownlow School. The trail
begins at Luttrell and Glenwood. A trail guide will
be found in a box at the start of the trail.

U.T. Gardens Agriculture Campus

Established in 1983 by the Department of Plant
Sciences, the UT Gardens are recognized as one
out of thirty-nine official All American Selections
(AAS) test sites in the United States.

The UT Gardens function as an outdoor laboratory
to evaluate the performance and landscape use
of every type of plant, from trees and shrubs to
annuals and perennials to ornamental grasses
and aquatic plants. Perhaps one of the most
important values of this nationally recognized
garden is the fact that it is located in the mid-
south where gardening and landscaping can be
quite challenging. Because of the extreme summer
heat and humidity common to Tennessee as well
as the variable winters where plants experience
frequent freezing and thawing, the test gardens
are important proving grounds for the leading
commercial seed and plant companies located
around the world.

The gardens are planted to demonstrate each
plants' ideal use in the landscape. In this manner,
visitors are not only able to see what plants
thrive and flourish in the Tennessee climate but
get ideas on garden design and how to use plants
in their own landscapes and gardens as well.
